Part 1**Building Numbering****§4-101. Short Title.**

This Part shall be known and may be cited as the “Reading Township House Numbering Ordinance.”

§4-102. Display of House Number or Address.

The following shall be required of all residences or dwellings located within the Township:

A. The house number or address of the residence or dwelling shall be displayed on the house and mailbox. On mailboxes, the number shall be displayed on both sides and on the front. If several, mailboxes are placed side by side, place the numbers on the front. On houses, the number shall be affixed to the house so as to be visible from the roadway. Where a home is located more than 300 feet from a roadway, the house need not be marked. However, if more than one home is located on a common drive, all houses must be marked so as to be visible from the lane or common drive.

B. These numbers shall be of contrasting color to the mailbox and the house, and shall be reflective. Numbers on houses and on the side of mailboxes, shall be no less than 3 inches in height. On the front of mailboxes, the numbers shall be no less than 1 inch high. All numbers should be plain, not script or other hard to read lettering.

§4-103. Notification of Noncompliance.

Upon notification of noncompliance by a member of the Board of Supervisors and/or their authorized representatives, the notified party shall have 15 days to comply with this Part. This notification may be in written or oral form.

§4-104. Notice of Requirements.

Upon issuance of a building permit, the Township Building Permit Officer shall inform the person to whom the permit is issued of the requirements of this Part.

§4-105. Penalty for Violation.

Any person who shall violate the provisions of §4-102 hereof shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of no less than \$5 and costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for not more than 1 day. Any person who shall violate the provision of this Part after having received notice under §4-103 hereof shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of

not less than \$5 nor more than \$300 and costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment for not more than 10 days. Provided: Each day's violation of either §4-102 or §4-103 of this shall constitute a separate violation.
