MINUTES

Mr. Thomason stated he attended an event held by the organization Wreaths Across America for Veterans. It was held at the Union Cemetery in East Berlin and wreaths were placed on the graves of the Veterans. He was very impressed and said it was very emotional. He would like to thank them for doing what they do.

ENGINEER'S REPORT AND PLANS

Dollar General

At last month's Board of Supervisors meeting the question was asked as to who owns the Dollar General store, they would be responsible to maintain the basin. Mr. Fox stated after some research he found that Dollar General is owned by Seafood Bonus located in Philadelphia.

Chesterfield

Mr. Fox stated he received a letter on December 16th from Daewood regarding the basin that was holding water which said they understand the Ordinance and they understand they are not in compliance. They are going to address the issue, but it will not be until Spring. Chairman Holtzinger stated he visited the site and there was still around a foot of water or more which is not a good situation.

Hampton Heights Phase V Bond

The Township currently does not hold a bond for Hampton Heights Phase V. A bond reduction letter was submitted in the amount of \$397,928.52 however there was a mathematical error, and the amount should have been \$436,941.12. There are items on the list that state they are completed and are not. Mr. Phillips made a motion to table the bond until January's Board of Supervisors meeting when all the items are completed.

Mr. Phillips made a motion to accept the Board of Supervisors meeting dates for 2023, second by Mr. Thomason; motion carried unanimously.

Appoint Smith, Elliot Kerns-Township Accountants to perform 2022 Audit

Mr. Phillips made a motion to appoint Smith, Elliot Kerns to perform the 2022 audit, second by Mr. Thomason; motion carried unanimously.

Heidlersburg request for an Ordinance to bill Insurance companies

No action was taken.

Consideration and Action-Purchase of fuel tank

Mr. Phillips made a motion to purchase a 1000-gallon fuel tank plus accessories needed, second by Mr. Thomason; motion carried unanimously.

Consideration and Action-Pipe replacement on Turkey Pit Road

The Township received money from the County from their ARPA funds in the amount of \$31,839.16. Chairman Holtzinger would like to use that money for the pipe replacement on Turkey Pit Road. Public Works furnished a quote in the amount of \$29,600.00. Mr. Phillips made a motion to approve the pipe replacement on Turkey Pit Road, second by Mr. Thomason; motion carried unanimously.

Reappointment of John Biese to the LMMA Board

Mr. Phillips made a motion to approve the reappointment of John Biese to the Lake Meade Municipal Authority Board, second by Mr. Thomason; motion carried unanimously. The Board thanked Mr. Biese for his service.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The Treasurer's Report for the month of November were approved pending audit on a motion by Mr. Phillips, second by Mr. Thomason; motion carried unanimously.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

The Board acknowledged receiving reports from the Police, Public Works, Zoning/Code Enforcement Officer and Building Inspector, Emergency Management and Northeast Adams Fire & EMS, and the LMMA Financial Statement.

Mr. Phillips made a motion to accept the Administrative Reports as presented, second by Mr. Thomason; motion carried unanimously.

SOLICITOR REPORT

Attorney Smith stated the bid limits will be \$22,500 and for quotes 12,200.
